



Dear Year 2 parents,

Welcome to the summer term! Please find the curriculum for this term below.

SUBJECT	TOPICS
MATHS	Number and Place value: estimating, counting, comparing and ordering. Adding and subtracting using mental calculation strategies. Multiplication and division: times tables and problem solving. Fractions: Finding fractions of quantities and shapes. 2D and 3D shapes, handling data, position and direction, measures, time and money.
LITERACY	<i>Read, Write, Inc</i> or <i>Literacy & Language</i> as normal. Children will also continue reading with year 5 Buddies.
SCIENCE	Plants, animals and the environment.
HISTORY	Great Fire of London
PE	Indoor PE will include Dance and Gymnastics. Outdoor PE will be Games.
ICT (taught by Mrs Smithson)	An introduction to digital photography. An introduction to emailing.
ART	1 st half term - Looking at an artist - Monet.
DT	2 nd half term - Growing and eating vegetables.
RE (taught by Mrs Hope)	1 st half term - Religious Leaders. 2 nd half term - Easy Questions, Hard Answers.
MUSIC	Sounds Interesting & Rain, Rain Go Away. The children will also be learning how to play the Glockenspiels.

Homework and Spelling books – This will continue to be set every Wednesday. Children need to bring both their spelling and homework books back to school on the following Monday.

Reading – Please remember to sign your child's reading record weekly so that they can change their reading books. Please feel free to write comments on their reading as these are always very useful. We usually have some quiet reading time each day so children should bring their reading books to school every day. They are also welcome to bring in a book from home (in addition to their school reading books) which they can read at this time.

Uniform - Children can now wear summer uniform until the October half term. Just a reminder that long hair needs to be tied. Jewellery of any kind is not allowed. Earrings need to be removed for school or taped over. Also, nail varnish is not allowed and needs to be removed as soon as possible.

PE Kits - Please return all PE kits to school as we are still missing one or two. Children will need PE shoes that fit well. PE lessons are now on Tuesdays and Thursdays.

KS1 Sats - As you may be aware, KS1 sats are planned for the week commencing 15th May 2017. Sats are nothing for you or your child to worry about. They will take place in the classroom with me and will be part of the normal school day.
